You can smell the dramaturgy on this quirky ensemble piece — it's that tight and polished (if a little solipsistic). Ten nervous passengers board an airline flight, including one woman whose hysteria becomes uncontainable. The easy jokes about airport security, moving sidewalks and terrorist panic are cute enough, but the show really cooks when, like a pageant of the seven deadly sins, the characters reveal their various neuroses and evil-doings. Even at its silliest — perhaps especially at its silliest — I Will Not Hatch! cleverly critiques the dangers of a society built on fear and shame.
